Nature Field Trip Grant Application

The Michigan Nature Association announces the availability of \$500 grants for field trips to natural areas for the 2017-2018 school year. These grants are intended to assist teachers in developing fun, hands-on field trips for teaching students about the natural environment. The grants can cover bus transportation and educational supplies for field trips to eligible natural areas, including community nature centers, MNA sanctuaries, state parks, and other conservation lands deemed suitable for field trips. MNA is especially interested in applications from urban schools with limited access to natural areas.

- 2. Narrative (Use separate pages)** - Include a brief educational objective, summary of the project, budget, and timeline.
